We have had an exciting week in Preschool. We have introduced our amazing new curriculum 'Marvellous Me!' for our Caterpillar class (2-3 year olds) and 'All about Me' for our Butterflies (3-4 year old).

We began our week discussing our families and what the word 'family' means. The children painted their portraits using a mirror to identify features of their face They also began identifying different body parts and then used some of these to explore paint and printing.

Our Caterpillar class have shown great interest in sorting items into matching coloured bowls. All the children have enjoyed some free flow play in the garden and have been excited to use the new sandpit!
